'I DON'T WANT SECOND DIVISION PLAYERS, AT LUTON'

says manager DAVID PLEAT

WE'VE got good players. If you know the set up, the people I have working with me on the staff and the quality of the players, then my aim must be for promotion."

The speaker was Luton boss, David Pleat, talking about the Kenilworth Road club's prospects for the coming season after they had beaten Oldham 6-1 on the opening day.

"Our major signings are Bob Hatton from Blackpool, David Moss from Swindon, Chris Turner from Peterborough and Mark Aizlewood from Newport," he continues. "We have also taken Mal Donaghy from Larne and Kirk Stephens from Nuneaton.

"I'm a realist: I shall be fair to the honest players. In the end everything we achieve will be put down to the character of the players we engage at the club. There'll be no prima donnas, only lads who are prepared to work and fight, even when things are not going well.

"Attitude and ability is what I look for in a player. David Moss is one of the most talented wingers in the country. I can't name six who are better. When we make a signing we are bringing in people who can play First Division football — to me that's very important.

"We're not signing Second Division players; we're taking on those who we think with development, or with their experience and know-how, can do a job in the top flight for this club.

"The style of play we intend using is one that combines defence with attack. When we're

retreating we'll be on the lookout for the quick break should we win the ball. When we're moving forward we'll be glancing over our shoulder to see if there's enough numbers at the back in case the opposition break out.

"I prefer to watch from the stand, but there will be occasions when I will be in the trainer's box. I like to peer down and try to detach myself from the frantic feelings generated on the bench. I get a more constructive view this way.

"I'm determined, but not greedy. I want to do well for Luton Town and I'll tell SHOOT! readers why.

"The board of directors have, in the past, come under criticism. Yet they've shown great faith in me and I intend to repay their judgment by fielding a team to be proud of, a club that can begin to compete with the best.

"They have appreciated and recognised my efforts over the past four years in all aspects. I don't hide the pleasure I have received from the progress of several players I have brought into this club.

"Steve Buckley is one who has since moved on, but others such as Ricky Hill and Brian Stein are very much a part of this club's future.

"In my short period at the helm we have manipulated in the transfer market. Our judgment will now be tested. With reasonable luck and a good run of the ball I am sure we can have an exciting season."

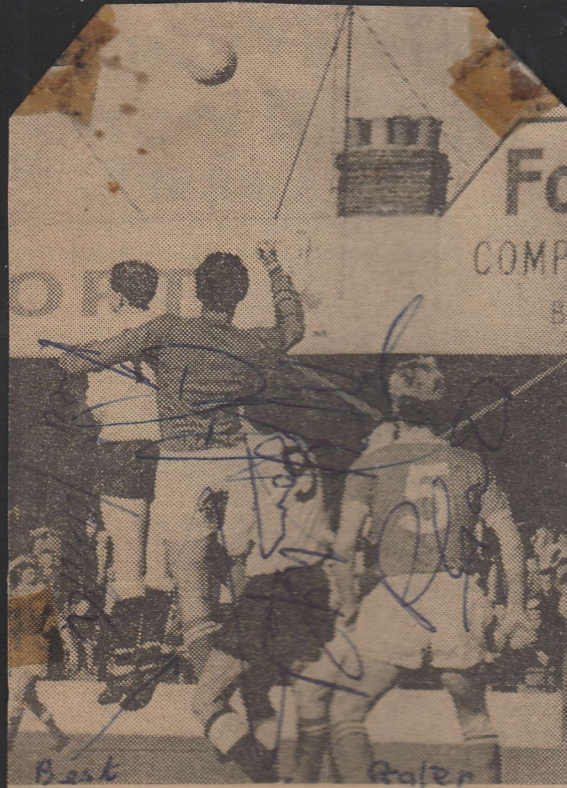
