IN his own words, Irishman Ray Treacy is a "midget". But that has not stopped him from becoming one of the most lethal strikers in the Second Division and a regular international for Eire. Not bad for a player

who did not start playing competitive football until he was 14 years old! Dublin-born Ray explains for SCORCHER and SCORE: "Football was frowned upon in the schools I attended. Hurling or Gaelic football were the main sports.

"It was only when I was 14 and joined local side Home Farm that I started playing soccer regularly. This is a club where many of the Irish players now in England began their careers."

Ray, still only 25, did so well in those games for Home Farm, that he achieved the unique distinction of being chosen for the Irish international schools team without ever playing for his school. When representing his country he was spotted by the West Bromwich Albion manager at the time, Gordon Clarke, and he was asked to join the

Midland club.

"I was at Albion about six years," Ray continues. "But it seemed there was no place for a 5ft 7ins, and 9st 3lb. midget striker in their future plans and I only ever made two first-team appearances.

"In the latter part of my career at Albion I moved into the midfield, a position, incidentally, that I still prefer to this day. "Anyway, London club Charlton wanted to sign me on as a striker, which goes to show that height really does not matter in the game, and as I

wanted first team football, I readily agreed. "I enjoyed it tremendously at first, but unfortunately last season I was in dispute with the club over a personal matter and when the offer came to join player-manager Dave Mackay at Swindon, I jumped at the chance." Ray went to Swindon for a £40,000 fee in June.

HARD WORK RAY has made the grade in football by sheer hard work and cannot really name anyone in particular who has helped him to develop his career.

He continues: "Looking back, I can't say I have anyone special to thank, but as a boy I always idolised big Charlie Hurley, the ex-Sunderland and Eire centre-half. I promised myself then that I would also play in England one day."

With one ambition fulfilled, his next is to return to Ireland to manage a leading local club — but only when he's finished his playing days with Swindon.

He concludes: "Football in Swindon is growing fast and I want to try and help its growth in every way I can. Players at the club, like former Manchester United full-back Shay Brennan, have introduced many great ideas and the whole scene is now more professional and competitive.'

The Swindon fans can look forward to success this season ... especially with players like Ray Treacy in the side. We wish him and the club the very best of luck!
