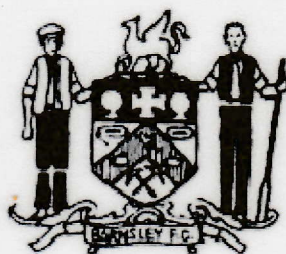

Robert Williamson (goalkeeper). Latest recruit at Barnsley. He has had previous experience with St Mirren and Arbroath and is 28 years old. Bob was born at Edinburgh and released by St. Mirren after being originally retained by them at the end of last season.

Allan Hopper (right back). Allan came to the fore two seasons ago when he reached top form. He was signed from South Shields in February 1961.

Eric Brookes (left back). Eric, a local born player, is also a former Barnsley Schoolboys' player and a former England Youth International. He became a professional in April 1961 and made his league debut while on the Club Groundstaff.

Bobby Wood (right half and captain). Bobby who joined the Club twelve years ago from Hibernians is a 100% worker and is always ready to try a shot at goal. He has given Barnsley great service.

Eric Winstanley (centre half). Eric who joined the Club Groundstaff from Barnsley Boys' Team is another former England Youth International. He got his chance last season following the retirement of Stewart Duncan Sharp. Eric became a professional in May of last year.

Billy Houghton (left half). Billy, a strong wing half, is another Barnsley born player who graduated through the local schoolboys' team. He is also a former Youth International. He became a professional in May 1957.

Jimmy Sheavills (outside right). Made 23 first team appearances for Peterborough last season, signing for Barnsley in June. He joined Peterborough from Holbeach United in March 1960.

George Kerr (inside forward). George was signed in May 1960, from the Scottish Junior Club Vale Juniors. He is a clever ball player.

Tony Leighton (centre forward). Tony was given a free transfer by Doncaster Rovers at the end of season 1961/62, although the Club's leading goalscorer. Barnsley promptly snapped him up. He is a useful cricketer as well as a thrusting forward.

Hugh Cochrane (inside forward). Hugh is twenty years old and signed forms for Barnsley after being with Dundee United.

Eddie O'Hara (outside left). Eddie was signed in the close season last year from Morton, the Scottish club. He had previously played with Rotherham.

Pat Wright (Rotherham 1970-71)

Len Beel—In his third year at The Gay Meadow, having been taken on from Leominster Town, his local club, as an apprentice professional. Now a full-timer. Made his Third Division debut last winter.

Full-backs:

Ken Turner—Hails from Barnsley and began with Huddersfield as an amateur wing-half, but later switched to full-back after joining the paid ranks. Moved to Shrewsbury earlier in the season.

Pat Wright—Had three seasons with Birmingham City and is now in his third year with the Town. He made 19 appearances in the senior team last winter and has created an impression as a strong defender.

Peter Wall—Recently given his first chance in the League side. Hails from Westbury, Shropshire, and joined the club straight from schools football.

Law Richardson—Another youngster who has also been seen to advantage at wing-half. A local boy who is making progress through the usual reserve channels.

Half-backs:

Eric Brodie—Utility player who is at home at wing-half or in the forward line. Was three seasons with Forfar and had two with Dundee United, making eight First Division appearances last year. A Scotland junior international.

Peter Dolby—He, too, is a real handyman and can operate at full-back, wing-half and inside-forward as well as at centre-half, where he has been a regular choice this season after 21 games last winter. Came from Heanor.

Albert Harley—Recruited as a ground staff boy from Lache, a junior club in his native Chester, in 1956, and awarded a benefit two years ago at the age of 22. Industrious wing-half or inside-forward.

Ted Hemsley—Only 20 and a star in the making. Was a Wolves amateur, and signed from Highley Miners. A Stoke boy, he made 29 Third Division appearances last season. Plays cricket for Worcestershire.

Tony Harris—Shropshire lad from Berrington and a wing-half whose progress will be watched with interest. He was signed from school.

Bob Walters—Six-footer from Glasgow who joined the club last year and made his first appearance during the season. He was spotted playing for Winsford United in the Cheshire League.



Shrewsbury Town player-manager **ARTHUR ROWLEY** recently had an outing at centre-half during an emergency, though he will always be known for his goalscoring exploits at inside-forward. Has been absent through injury much of the season. (Central.)

Forwards:

George Boardman—Former Scotland amateur international inside-forward who scored a dozen goals in 34 outings for Queens Park last season and was persuaded to sign professional forms by manager Arthur Rowley.

Frank Clarke—This rangy leader from Willenhall was an amateur before coming on the payroll more than two years ago. Was previously with St. Giles, Walsall and has a brother, Allan, who plays for Walsall. Last season: 17 games, 9 goals.

Derek Dawes—A light, elusive player brought from Dawley Schools in 1959. If he fulfils his

early promise he should become a very good player. Last season he made seven senior appearances.

John Gregson—This former Blackpool right-winger had 32 matches for Chester last season and created a fine impression. Shrewsbury signed him and gave him twelve outings in the last few weeks of the campaign.

Derek Hines—One-time England Youth international centre-forward who had fourteen years with Leicester City before joining Shrewsbury. Now 33, he had three senior games last year and spends much of his time helping the up-and-coming youngsters. *Rugby*

Harry Middleton—Experienced campaigner who had 31 matches last winter, scoring 11 goals. Was with Wolves, Scunthorpe United and Portsmouth before returning to the Midlands with Shrewsbury.

Billy Nixon—Inside-forward or wing-half who is currently out of action with a broken leg. Was brought over from Distillery by Norwich City, who sold him to the Town two years ago. Ten games last season.

Bobby Ross—After transferring Jimmy McLaughlin to Swansea during the summer Town snapped up Ross from Heart of Midlothian. Has since been moved from the wing to an inside-forward berth. Had eight First Division outings last year.

Arthur Rowley—"Mr. Shrewsbury" and veteran of many distinguished campaigns, the player-manager has beaten Jimmy McGrory's British record of 410 goals. Last season (24 in 40 matches) was the thirteenth consecutive season in which he has topped 20 goals. Previously with West Bromwich, Fulham and Leicester.
