Les Bradd makes a County challenge

THE fact that Notts County won promotion to the Second Division last season and Rotherham United were relegated to the Fourth presents no immediate link. But for County striker Les Bradd the situation produced an ironic twist. Bradd, born in Rotherham, had only three appearances for his home club, being unable to break into the side on a regular basis. County snapped him up in the 1967-68 season and since then he has made over 200 League appearances for them and helped fight back into the Second Division. Last season he hit 13 goals in all competitions, finishing as one of County's three most successful strikers behind Kevin Randall and Jon Nixon. He was top scorer 1971-72 with 21 League goals and is one of the club's most popular players. Bradd may be finding it a bit more difficult to score goals in the Second Division, but he is still playing a very useful part in County's shock challenge for promotion to the First Division.

NOTTs COUNTY have a simple solution when they're a bit short in the goal stakes. They send for Brian Stubbs. The tall centre-back has knocked in a few important goals since he came into the side during the 1968-69 season. One of them set County on the way to that sensational 4-1 win over Palace at Selhurst Park on the opening day of the current campaign. Palace were ahead at the time big Brian stormed up to head County's first goal. But this is something he is good at. County use him, as Leeds once used Jack Charlton, and at corners and set-pieces Brian can be the fellow who kept the defenders occupied to give his forwards more space. His height in these situations is invaluable. Brian easily tops six feet and makes an ideal aerial target man. This dominance in the air has also helped him to become the master of all situations at the back. Brian is as popular with the fans as he is with the players and has been Player of the Year. But, of course, he's tall enough to get noticed!

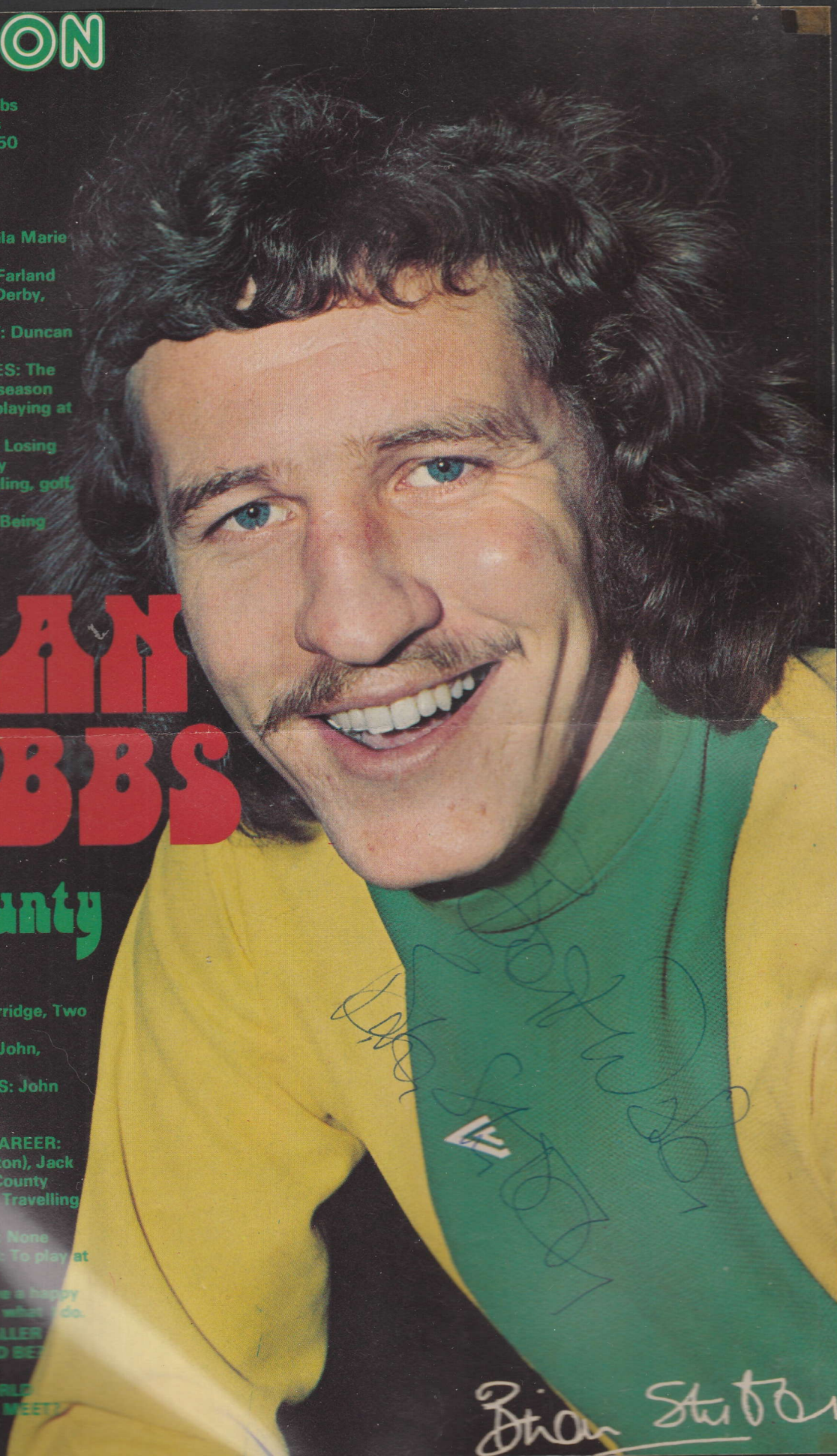
